Zakes Mda and Greg Marinovich win the 2017 Sunday Times Literary Awards

Congratulations to PEN SA Member Zakes Mda who has been named the winner of the Barry Ronge Prize for fiction at the *Sunday Times* Literary Awards for his novel *Little Suns*. The award ceremony was held on Saturday 24 June at The Empire in Parktown, Johannesburg. Greg Marinovich won the Alan Paton Award for non-fiction for his book *Murder at Small Koppie: The Real Story of the Marikana Massacre*.

"Memory itself is essentially fictive, and since we are what we remember, our work creates us as we create it." - Read the keynote address that Mda gave at the ceremony.

Chinese Writer-Activist Liu Xiaobo Released on Medical Parole for Late-Stage Cancer

PEN SA is pleased at the news that the Chinese dissident writer and Nobel laureate Liu Xiaobo has been released from prison. Even with this good news PEN SA would like to make it clear that the Chinese government's relentless repression against the opposition and the disregard for freedom of expression remains a great concern.

"News that Chinese dissident writer and Nobel laureate Liu Xiaobo is suffering from late-stage liver cancer and has been released from prison on medical grounds is a painful reminder that President Xi Jinping and his regime will go to any lengths to crush opposition, PEN America said in a statement today. Liu was moved from prison to a hospital about a month ago."...read more
