It is a day that marks, globally, the persecution and imprisonment of writers peacefully exercising their right to freedom of expression.

This year's cases include **Cesario Alejandro Félix Padilla Figueroa** (Honduras), **Nguyen Ngoc Nhu Quynh** (Vietnam), **Ramón Esono Ebalé** (Equitorial Guinea), **Razan Zaitouneh** (Syria), and **Zehra Doğan** (Turkey). 
